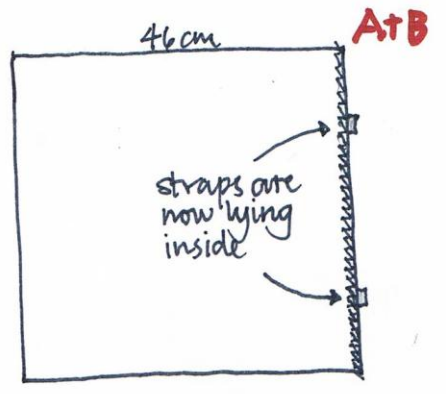
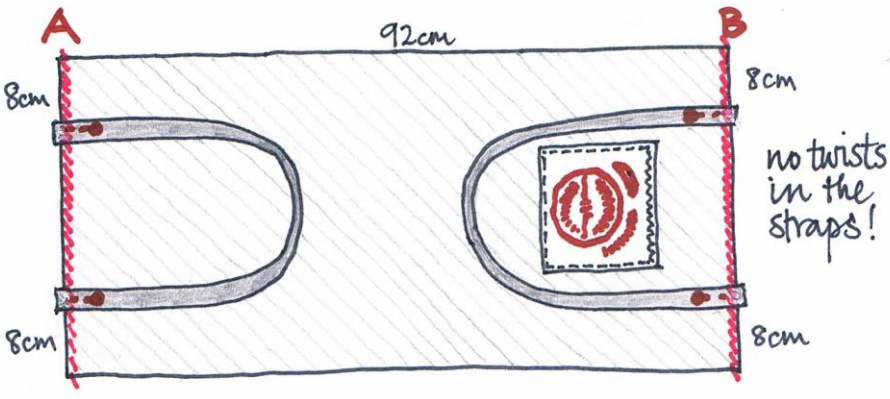
## Don't sew?

- ironing.

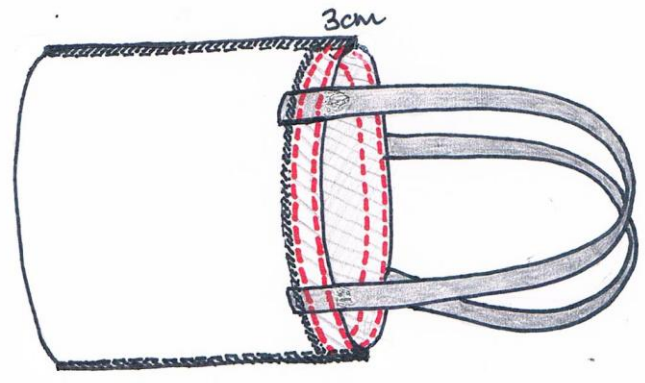
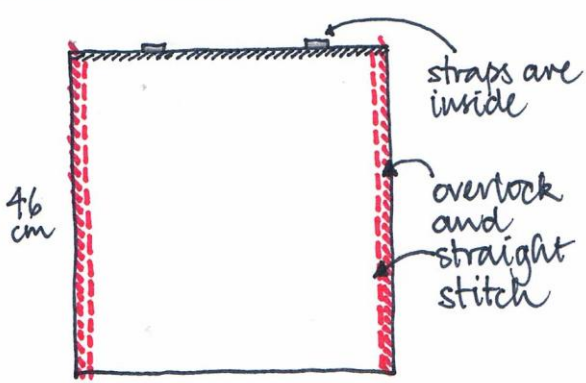






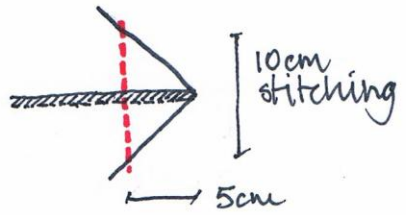
5 Pin straps to bag, overlock ends to attach

6 Fold in half inside out



7 Sew sides

8 Fold top down 3cm, sew twice round top

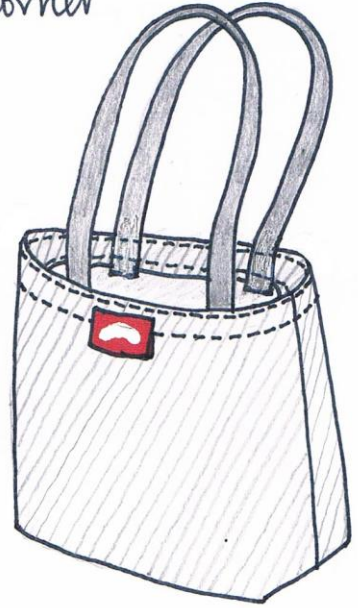


lay side seam along centre fold of bottom of bag, stitch across it at 5cm in from corner

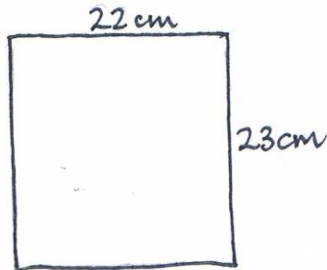
9 Fold and sew corners to form flat base

10 Turn bag right side out

Sew on a Boomerang Bag label (if you like)  
Quality control: check that it's all correctly sewn, tidy up any threads and... **it's good to go!**

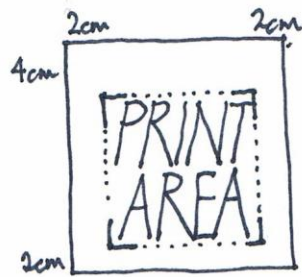
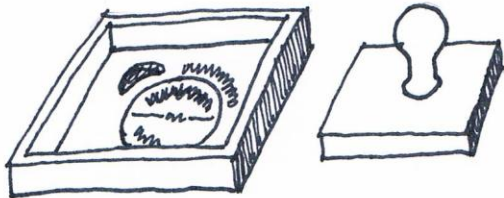


# How to make a Boomerang Bag pocket



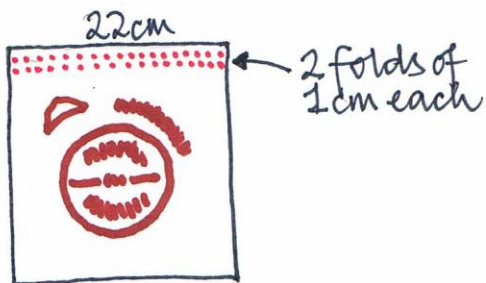
choose plain white or light colours

1 Cut out pockets.

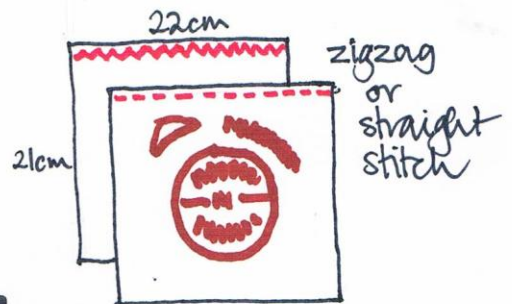


keep print away from edges

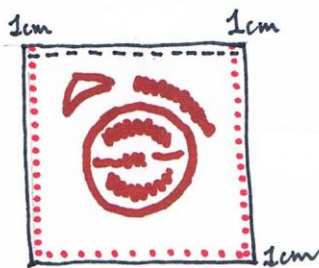
2 Print or stamp, then iron to fix



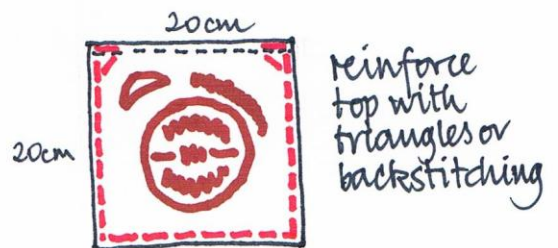
3 Fold & iron top



4 Sew across top



5 Fold & iron sides & bottom edge



6 Sew pocket on to bag
